FINDINGS

Excess bowel gas affects accuracy of the examination.

There is a small thin - walled cyst in right lobe of the liver d ~ 13 - 14 mm and a smaller d ~ 7 mm in the left lobe. The rest of the imaged liver parenchyma shows normal and homogenous echotexture. No signs of hepatomegaly.

No intra- or extrahepatic biliary dilatation is seen.

Gallbladder is normal in size, without signs of wall thickening or gallstones.

Imaged segments of the pancreas and spleen are normal.

Both kidneys demonstrate normal size and cortical echogenicity with intact corticomedullary demarcation. No signs of hydronephrosis. No prominent focal lesion is seen. However, further investigation with MRI is recommended, to exclude any focal lesion in RT kidney, as it is described in a recent lumbar MRI (artifact?? true lesion??).

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
